As you know, following the announcement by the Prime Minister all schools closed on Friday 20th March.

However, for students in receipt of free school meals we are making the following provision available so that they are still able to access a free school meal each day:

For students who receive free school meals who are attending school for supervision because they are either the children of key workers OR are vulnerable children.	Hot meal to be served at Goodwin Academy provided free
For students who receive free school meals but are NOT attending school for supervision because they are NOT either the children of key workers OR are NOT vulnerable children.	Food parcel to be collected from school once per week

Surnames starting with C or D	Wednesday 25 th March between 10 am – 11 am	Tuesday 31 st March between 10 am – 11 am
Surnames starting with E, F or G	Wednesday 25 th March between 11 am – 12 pm	Tuesday 31 st March between 11 am – 12 pm
Surnames starting with H	Wednesday 25 th March between 12 pm – 1 pm	Tuesday 31 st March between 12 pm – 1 pm
Surnames starting with I, J, K, L or T	Thursday 26 th March between 9 am – 10 am	Wednesday 1 st April between 9 am – 10 am
Surnames starting with M or N	Thursday 26 th March between 10 am – 11 am	Wednesday 1 st April between 10 am – 11 am
Surnames starting with O, P or R	Thursday 26 th March between 11 am – 12 pm	Wednesday 1 st April between 11 am – 12 pm
Surnames starting with S or W	Thursday 26 th March between 12 pm – 1 pm	Wednesday 1 st April between 12 pm – 1 pm

Please adhere to your time slots for collection and keep a two-metre distance between staff and other parents.
