IMPORTANT

Following the Christmas break, if your child or anyone in your household develops symptoms **on or after Wednesday 23rd December** please book a test and seek advice from the nhs.uk website at www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/ . If this is a positive test please email office@goodwinacademy.org.uk before Monday 4th January, and we will then advise you on your child's return date to school.

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
